

Knitterella's Heart Pattern

What You'll Need:

FYI: Really, you can use any scrap yarn with compatible needles. Gauge doesn't matter. Below is what I used for the heart photoed here.

- small amounts Berroco, Touché (my gauge was 5 sts per inch)
- size 5 dpns
- compatible crochet hook
- tapestry needle
- buttons to embellish (optional)

Size:

Finish size approximately 3" height, by 3" wide - this will vary depending on the yarn you use.

Stitch Guide:

st(s): stitch or stitches

KFB: knit in front and back of stitch

K2tog: knit 2 together

SSK: slip, slip, knit 2 slipped stitches together

P2tog: purl 2 together

Let's Start!

cast on 2 sts

Rnd 1: Purl

Rnd 2: KFB of each sts. (4 sts on needle)

Rnd 3: (and all odd rows), Purl

Rnd 4: KFB of first sts, knit to last sts, KFB of last st (6 sts)

Rnd 6: KFB of first sts, knit to last sts, KFB of last st (8 sts)

Rnd 8: KFB of first sts, knit to last sts, KFB of last st (10 sts)

Rnd 10: KFB of first sts, knit to last sts, KFB of last st (12 sts)

Rnd 11-15: Knit the even rows and Purl the odd rows

Rnd 16: Knit 6 sts (will work on these 6sts only for rnds 16-19)

Rnd 17: Turn work and purl these 6 sts



Rnd 18: K1,SSK, K2tog, K1 (4 sts)

Rnd 19: P2tog twice, 2 stitches remain, without turning work, pull 1st st over 2nd st and off needle, cut yarn, pull through remaining loop and weave in end.

Join yarn to work the remaining 6 sts on needle, work rounds 16-19.

To Finish

With contrasting yarn, evenly single crochet a border all the way around.

Weave in ends.

Block (This part is important to flatten out and define the shape)

Embellish with buttons or embroidery or leave as is! These little hearts are great for embellishing your handknits or to use on a greeting card or as a pin or whatever your 'heart' desires!
